


**STATEMENT OF ARRANGEMENTS THAT HAVE BEEN TAKEN BY

## Crisis Management

### ***District Magistrate Office (DMD Section)***

The District Relief Office is entrusted with the overall monitoring and supervision of relief measures in case of a natural disaster to combat its devastating effects on behalf of the District Magistrate. Accordingly, it has designed a comprehensive plan to combat any eventuality.

### **Control Rooms:-**

A round the clock Control Room having Telephone (03462-255572) and Motorola R.T. facility will operate at the District Magistrate's Bungalow from June to October. Similarly, Control Rooms will function at the S.D.O.s' Offices and the B.D.O.s' Offices.

### **Rain Fall Data: -**

There are 8 (eight) centres under Central Water Commission in this district where rainfall data are regularly recorded and monitored. These data are communicated regularly to the District Administration. These records, duly updated, are displayed on the board in the office chamber of the District Magistrate.

Besides, Deputy Director (Agriculture), Birbhum also records rainfall data at various points in the district. These are duly communicated and displayed by the District Relief Office.

The, 04 Nos. of Fibre Glan Boats to be kept reserve 2 at labpur block and 02 nos. to be allotted for Rampurhat Sub-Divisional which have been supplied by the Civil Defence Deptt. Kolkata.

In case of heavy rainfall, storm etc. the district machinery is alerted through special warning messages from Alipore Metrological Office. The District Administration in turn alert the Sub-Divisional and Block control rooms over phone and wirelesses.

### **Water Level / Discharge:-**

The information regarding water levels of rivers are communicated by the I.&W. Department to the Control Room. All concerned S.D.O.s and B.D.O.s are alerted over R.T. and Telephone as soon as the river water reaches its danger level.

### **Storage of Relief Materials :-**

Considering a possible flood situation, the District Relief Office has planned to keep a reserve stock of relief articles as follows

i)	Tarpaulin Sheets	:	40,000 pcs
ii)	Dhuti	:	20,000 pcs
iii)	Sari	:	20,000 pcs
iv)	Children Garments	:	25,000 pcs
v)	Lungi	:	20,000 pcs


The State Government in the Relief Department will be moved for arrangement of above articles.

In case it becomes necessary to requisition the services of the Army for rescue on relief operation, the Chief Secretary, the Home Secretary, the Principal Secretary Disaster Management Department will be contacted over phone.

Required country boats 10 nos. to be hired for rescue purpose.

Required Cash G.R. Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh) only.

Requirement Contingency fund Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh) only.
