1. 10+2 with Diploma or Certificate course in Medical Laboratory Technology or its equivalent
2. Minimum 2 years of experience of working in a Bacteriological Laboratory of repute.

Preferable Qualification of Sputum Collector (may be given to that person that have): -


Minimum one-year experience in RNTCP work.

Job Specification/Responsibility of Sputum Collector: -

Sputum collection from TB suspects referred from outpatients of the same facility, the surrounding community, and other facilities linked in the vicinity. Collect diagnostic and follow up sputum specimens following RNTCP guidelines. Ensure adherence to guidelines on sputum collection in order to obtain good quality sputum samples, staining & microscopy from nearest DMC. Ensure accurate recording in lab forms and dispatch lists, labeling, recording and packaging of samples. Ensure that a mechanism for transportation is in place by own vehicle and that there is timely communication of sputum results back to referring providers.

Sputum collection Charge:

Sputum collection charges of Rs. 10/- (Ten) per slide (including sputum collection, transportation, staining, microscopy & sputum results back to referring providers). This will be paid monthly from District Health & Family Welfare Samiti, Birbhum.


