



Sir / Madam,

Health Sector Reforms under the National Rural Health Mission aims to increase functional, administrative and financial resources and autonomy to the field units under which every PHC will get Rs. 50,000/- per annum as Annual Maintenance Grant for improvement and maintenance of physical infrastructure of the Primary Health Centres. Provisions of water, electricity, toilet and their maintenance shall be given priority.


2. The Annual Maintenance Grant may be utilized for the following purposes:
 - (i) Repair / renovation, maintenance and replacement of doors, windows, toilets and other fixtures of the PHC building and Staff quarters.
 - (ii) Whitewashing of the walls of the PHC building and staff quarters.
 - (iii) Cleaning and scavenging of the PHC building and premises, including staff quarters.
 - (iv) Construction and maintenance of water supply infrastructure for staff and patient.
 - (v) Construction and maintenance of electrical infrastructure of the PHC including staff quarters.
3. The Annual Maintenance Grant should be so utilized so that there is no duplication of activities taken up under RCII-II / Gram Panchayat fund or any other programme.
